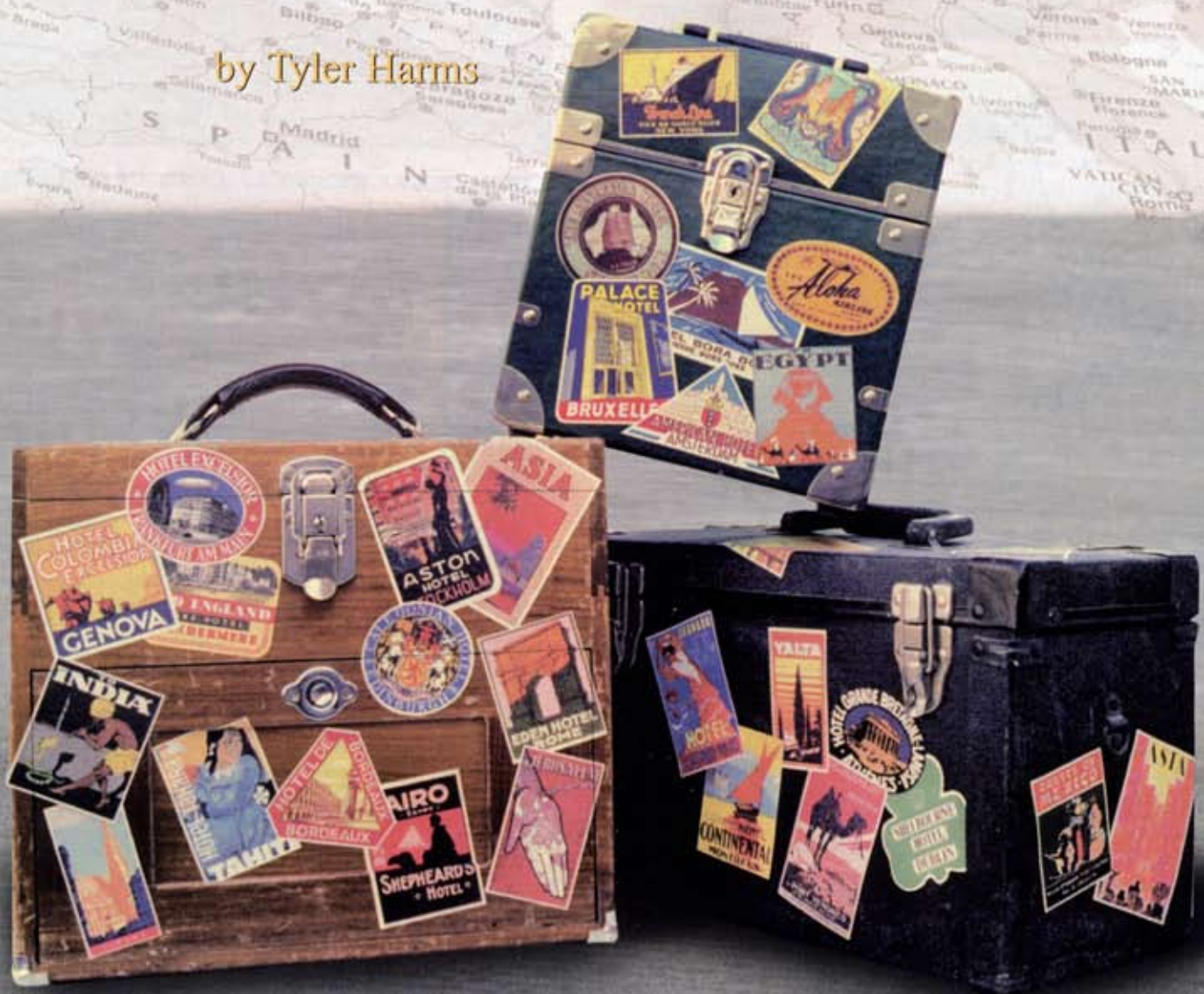

Through the vast amount of photographs and letters received at the magazine from artists spanning the globe, it has become apparent that such communities are growing around the world, and the artists comprising these communities are generating quality, innovative work.

In years past, the make-up industry flourished in just a handful of areas; how times have changed. India, for example, has become the largest film market, producing over 600 films a year, subsequently employing more than 1,000 make-up artists. SWEDEN

Goran Lundstrom of the EffectStudio in Stockholm is one of the most prominent make-up artists in Sweden. Goran and company are constantly creating designs and prosthetics for the motion picture, commercial and print industries in Europe.



DENMARK

The author and artist behind the book *Body Painting*, **Patrick Lies** is a self-taught artist who began his career as an illustrator for an advertising agency. His interest in body painting began at the Copenhagen Carnival where he decorated the faces of carnival participants. In 1994 he began full-body painting, and since then his career has included work in movies, music videos and Danish television. He teaches regularly at various make-up schools and exhibitions and was the 1996 European Champion for the Fardel Body Painting Contest in Brussels, Belgium.



JAPAN

Henry Susumu Hidaka graduated from the Max Factor Beauty School in Tokyo, Japan in 1970. As a hairstylist and make-up artist, he has worked in television dramas and commercial films, fashion shows, and magazines.
